

Montana Grand Assembly Dress Code

Dress code as suggested by JEC, October, 2013

The core values of the International Order of the Rainbow for Girls encourage a proper dress code. Only with our bodies appropriately covered can we promote the ideals of Rainbow and affect respect from those we come in contact with. A proper dress code sets Rainbow Girls apart from the crowd.

- Dresses must have straps, any kind of strap is OK (including halter)
- Dresses cannot have plunging necklines, the neckline cannot extend below an imaginary line drawn across the chest from armpit to armpit. The back should not fall below the natural bra line.
- Slits in dresses or skirts should not go above the knee
- "Finger-tip" rule applies to the length of dresses, the hemline must be at or below the fingertips while standing with arms at the sides
- Dresses may be of any color. If black they should not be more than 50% black.
- Nylons are not required
- Shoes that make noise while walking (such as flip flops) are not allowed. Open toe shoes are allowed
- Bikini swimwear is OK but must have thick straps, no string bikinis
- Cover ups must be worn when walking to and from the pool
- ***Most important dress code rule is...the Mother Advisor has the last say. If doesn't matter if all the above rules are followed, if the Mother Advisor says it is inappropriate then cannot be worn.***
